

## Daily Activities

The following days will also focus on:

### Monday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>

**Session 1: Collage with Amy:** Students will use watercolor and oriental papers to create a collage. They will draw a composition from a still life, then use the collage materials to add color and texture. Students will learn about the history of collage and view examples of collages created by other artists

**Session 2: Printing & Stamping with Joan:** Students will experiment with creating unique stamps from found and recycled objects. The stamps will be used to create a print, a card, or can be used on fabric. Students will view examples of various prints and textiles. The group will also work on a collaborative piece using their created stamps.

### Tuesday, July 24<sup>th</sup>

**Full Day Session with Kristine & Torie:** Kristine and Torie will alternate teaching throughout the full day as each project requires drying time. Kristine will teach the art of batik, a decorative art used to embellish textiles. The process requires several steps working with fabric dyes and wax. Torie's project will focus on Henna inspired patterns. Students will use a layering process working with bright colored paint, glitter paint, gel pens and markers, on paper.

### Wednesday, July 25<sup>th</sup>

**Session 1: Sculpture with Angie:** Students will work with Sculpy to create colorful sculpture dragons, or turtles, with designs and glass beads.

**Session 2: Pastels with Joan:** Students will work with oil pastels and chalk pastels, learning various techniques for each medium. Students will view examples of work by artists working in pastels. Students will experiment and create unique works in each medium.
