Two 3 hour sessions per day

Wednesday, July 27th

Joan Cech leads 2 sessions. **Clay for the Day!**

9 am Students will explore techniques in clay and will use found objects to add texture to their piece. Items made for this session must be fired & picked up later.

1 pm - Clay sessions continue & **Annikka Klement** will teach additional creative activities such as making quilt ornaments that can be taken home that day.

Thursday, July 28th

9 am - **Gabrielle Comte** will teach various printmaking techniques utilizing objects which can often be found in the household. Participants will create more conventional prints using foam etching and **collography**--a technique in which materials are applied to a rigid surface and used as a printing plate. Students will also learn "bubble printing", the unconventional method of printing using dish soap and tempera paint. Prints may be taken home the day of the course or at a later date depending on the drying time.

1 pm: Angie Frier will teach techniques with sculpey clay involving design. Each student will create a personalized pen and a pen buddy out of clay that involves sculpting with a choice of designs such as initials or a figurine such as a panda. The items can be taken home that day. **Iris Prochaska** will co-teach.

Friday, July 29th:

9 am - **Katerina Reimers**. Students will learn the Japanese Shibori dying technique using traditional indigo dye. Please bring white t-shirts, tank tops, pillow cases or other fabrics to be dyed. They will create larger than life acrylic paintings with new and exciting techniques including using dish soap and water hoses! Students will create beautiful woven dream catchers using a variety of different mediums including beads, ribbon, feathers, yarn, and natural elements.

1 pm - **Katerina Reimers** Students will be offered a variety of art activities as **Annikka Klement** & **Emily Heermann** contribute their ideas & assist.
